Thank you for participating in Brunswick's Second Annual 10 X 10 Benefit Art Exhibit and Sale on October 1 & 2, 2010. This show is sponsored by Arts Are Elementary and Points of View Art Gallery in Brunswick, Maine. The criteria for submitting artwork are listed below. Please note the deadlines on your calendar.

The 10 X 10 Benefit Art Exhibit and Sale opens Friday, October 1, running from 5pm-8pm. It continues on Saturday, October 2, from 10am-2pm. The art may be on exhibit for the entire month of October.

The venues include three gallery spaces on Pleasant Street in Brunswick:

- Morrell Meeting Room in the Curtis Memorial Library, 23 Pleasant Street
- Very Special Arts Gallery at 11 Pleasant Street
- another gallery to be determined

Application information:

- Artists may submit between one and three pieces.
- Size of work must fall within a 10-inch square format.
- Canvas will be accepted only as 10"x 10" and **up to 3/4 "** deep.
- Finished work must be ready to put into 10 x 10 black metal frames.
- We provide 10 x 10 black metal frames, foam core and optional glass. No matting provided.
- All works of art will be priced at \$200. Proceeds from each sale will be divided equally between the artist and Arts Are Elementary.
- Frames on unsold work may be purchased by the artist for \$20.

Application fee:

A \$10.00 fee per artist, for up to three pieces, must be included with each application. Payment can be made by check, payable to "Arts Are Elementary, 10X 10" and mailed to AAE, 10 X 10, P.O. Box 882, Brunswick, ME 04011 or payment can be made online at www.artsareelementary.org.

July 3-Deadline for image to be considered for 10 X 10 publicity

September 4-Deliver artwork to Curtis Memorial Library, Morrell Meeting Room, 2:00pm-5:00pm

October 1-Show opening with reception, Friday, 5pm-8pm

October 2-Show continues, Saturday, 10am-2pm

We are seeking an original image to appear on publicity materials for our 2009 show. If you would like us to consider your artwork, please email a photo image to cmworth@myfairpoint.net by July 3. The 10 X 10 committee will review all entries and choose one image to be used on all publicity, including postcards, posters and programs.

Please bring with your artwork:

-Resume or bio, one page maximum

-Artist’s statement, one page maximum-tell us about yourself, what inspires your work, how you became an artist, etc.

Please submit each page in a separate 3 ring binder plastic sleeve. They will be placed in a book for public viewing.

-Delivered dry, fixed, matted (if you choose), and ready for framing, to Curtis Memorial Library, 23 Pleasant Street, Brunswick on Saturday, September 4 between 2:00pm and 5:00pm.
