



FAQS

1. Where and when is the event?

The event will take place on Saturday, November 9 from 10 AM - 1 PM at the Harriet Beecher Stowe Elementary School gymnasium in Brunswick.

2. How do I sign up to be a Maker?

All interested Makers should first fill out [our interest form here](#). Afterwards, a member of our team will send you our Makers Guidelines, which will include a Makers Agreement for you and your grownup to sign and return back to us.

3. Is there an age limit to participate?

Given the nature of the event, we are aiming for kids ages 6-16. If you have a child outside of that age range that wants to participate, please email us at CahootsMakersMarket@gmail.com and we can discuss.

4. Is there a deadline to sign up?

Yes, the deadline to fill out the [interest form](#) is Monday, November 4. However, we recommend submitting your form as soon as possible, as we may reach capacity before then.

5. Is it free to participate in this event?

Yes! While most grown up fairs require a booth or table rental fee to participate, we wanted to make sure all interested kids had access.

We will be ticketing the event to help cover the costs, but each Maker will be allowed one grownup helper for free.

6. Are there any restrictions on what I can sell at the event?

Makers can sell (almost) anything! However, below are restrictions:

- No food or beverages
- No weapons (or simulated weapons, handcrafted weapons)
- No animals
- No fundraisers
- Nothing related to politics or political campaigns
- No flames
- No MLM's

Additionally, Makers may not sell goods on behalf of their parents. Makers must have an active role in the production of the creations being sold.

If you have an item in question, please reach out to ask.

7. How will I collect payment?

This is totally up to you and your grown up and is your responsibility to manage. For cash transactions, we recommend having some cash on hand to make change. For Venmo/PayPal transactions, make sure you work that out with your grown up beforehand.

8. When can I arrive to set up my space? What is included in my space?

The event will open to the public at 10 AM, and Makers can arrive as early as 9:15 AM. Each Maker will be provided a 6 foot banquet table and two chairs in a pre-assigned spot. Event volunteers will be on hand to show you to your table space. Tables need to stay in their assigned spots and not be moved.

Any table decoration, signage, etc. is up to you to bring at your discretion. All Makers are expected to have at least one sign identifying their business name and something identifying prices.

9. Can I market myself beforehand?
